Cabin Codes

- Each room has its own six-digit pin code, followed by a hash symbol (#). Group members will be provided with their room code at the induction.
- Group Leaders will be issued a master fob for quick access to cabins, as well as a list of all the room codes.

Duress & Smoke Alarms

- Duress buttons are located inside the cabins for emergency use only.
- Smoke detectors located inside the cabins are sensitive to smoke, vapes, steam and spray from aerosol cans. A \$1,400 callout fee will apply for false alarms.

Exit Procedure

Before departure, please complete the following:

- All cabins to be checked by Group Leaders – ensure all rooms are swept and rubbish is removed.
- Luggage will be moved into our storage lockers at the Transit Centre, our Client Service Officers will assist you with this.
- If linen is supplied - Strip from beds and place in the linen bins provided.
